



Accepting Pregnant Teens in need of Group Care Intensive Services!



Specialized Services Include:

- Prenatal care by a local Board Certified OB-GYN.
- Consultation and assessment by a Registered Dietitian.
- Individual sessions to address increasing effective coping strategies and emotional health during pregnancy.
- Group interventions geared toward developing independent living skills that focus on healthy parenting.
- Group and individual interventions on preparing for a healthy baby.

Enrollment in Nurse-Family Partnership Program:

- Enrollment in the Nurse-Family Partnership program, which provides a specially trained DHEC nurse who meets with the teen on-site every 1-2 weeks throughout her pregnancy, with continued visits until her baby is 2 years old, providing maternal/child health education.

Enrollment in SC DHEC's Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program:

- WIC is a special, supplemental food program established to safe guard the nutritional well-being of pregnant women and children, during critical growth periods.
